In the field of aerospace engineering, he held high-ranking positions in the areas of development, production, service and program. Among others, he was the last Project Manager of Spacelab. With the creation of EADS in 2000, he was responsible for the management, integration and global development of the EADS Corporate Research Centre, with more than 800 researchers worldwide. He also served as Chief Operating Officer Innovation, and was part of the EADS Corporate Technical Office (CTO) from 2012 until 2014, for which he was in charge of external relations for research and technology, business development and interdisciplinary initiatives.

In addition to his professional accomplishments, Dr. Müller-Wiesner fulfilled and fulfils a variety of other roles and honorary positions. He is officer in the reserve of the German Air Force, a member and deputy spokesman of the Senate of the German Aerospace Society (DGLR), member of the Honorary Fellows of the International Council on Aeronautical Sciences (ICAS), a former member of the Board of Directors and former head of the office of the Aviation Initiative for Renewable Energies Germany (aireg e.V.).

He was President of the DGLR, President of ICAS, member of the Senate of the Helmholtz Association, member of the Supervisory Board of the German Research Institute for Artificial Intelligence, Chairman of the Advisory Board of Bauhaus Luftfahrt e.V., of the Scientific Advisory Board of the "Gauss Super Computing Centres (GSC) and a member of various boards of the Ludwig Bolkow Campus/the Ludwig Bolkow Campus GmbH, as well as of Munich Aerospace e.V.

He also holds the honorary title "Chevalier de l'Ordre National du Mérite du France" and is a corresponding member of the Academie de l'Air et de l'Espace in France.

Dr.-Ing. Müller-Wiesner studied Mechanical Engineering at Clausthal Technical University and received his PhD in 1985 in the field of operational strength.
